Worship Ministries

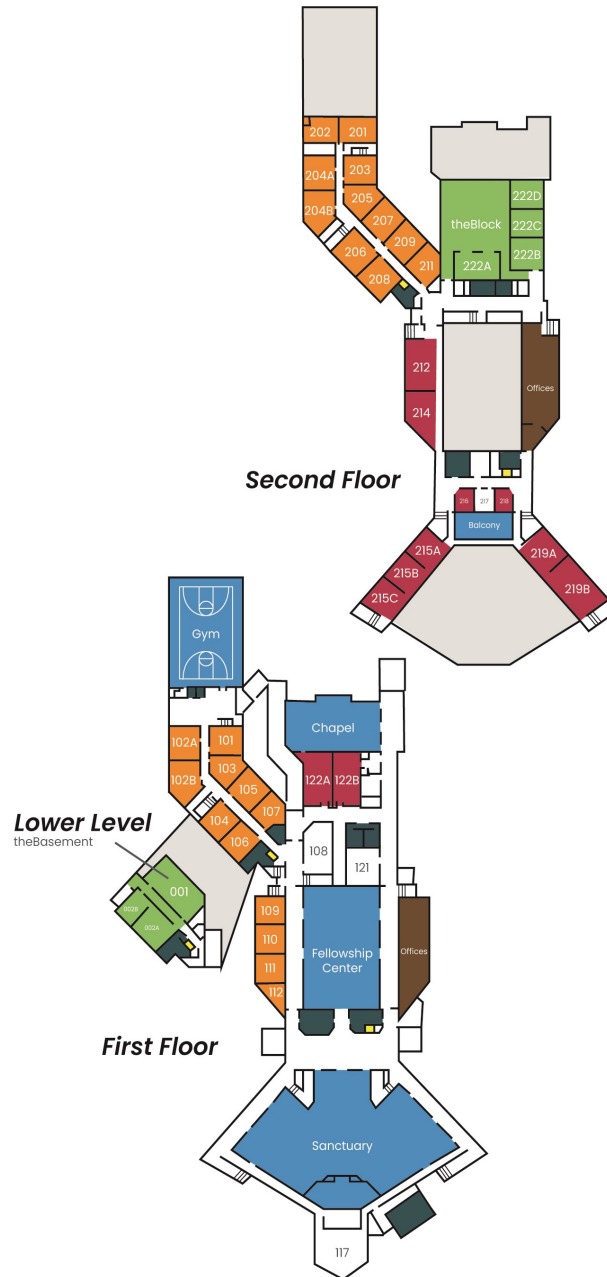
An adult class for those serving in Worship Ministries but open to all
